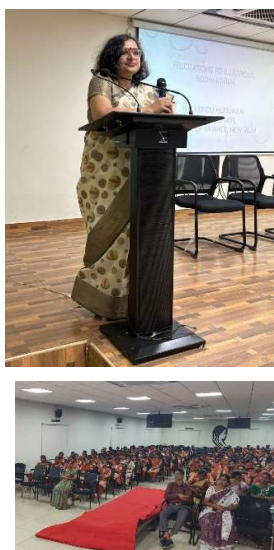
Faculty Development Programme
