Two-Day International Conference on “Green Hydrogen: Fuel of the Future”



The Department of Chemistry successfully organized a Two-Day International Conference on “Green Hydrogen: Fuel of the Future” (19th and 20th September 2025) in association with the All-India Chemistry Teachers Association (ACT) with the generous support of Siddhartha Management.

The conference aimed to bring together experts, academicians, researchers, and students to discuss the latest developments, opportunities, and challenges in the field of green hydrogen as a sustainable energy source.

The inaugural session was graced by eminent dignitaries and distinguished speakers like Sri Kommareddy Patabhi Ram, Chairman of Swachha Andhra Corporation Ltd (SACL), Prof. Mandava V.Basaveswara Rao, Rector, DEAN, CDC, Dept of Chemistry, Krishna University, Machilipatnam. Over the two days, the conference featured plenary talks, invited lectures, and

paper presentations covering diverse themes such as green hydrogen production technologies, storage, utilization, and its role in achieving net-zero targets. The program received overwhelming participation from faculty, research scholars, and students, providing a platform for knowledge exchange and collaboration. The conference proceedings have been compiled in a book with ISBN Number: 978-93-344-0787-7 further highlighting the academic value of the event. The conference featured eminent chief guests and invited speakers who shared their insights on the emerging field of **green** hydrogen. The discussions covered a wide range of topics, including production technologies, transportation, storage solutions, and applications of green hydrogen in diverse sectors. The speakers elaborated on the current status of hydrogen production in India and other countries, emphasizing the progress made in scaling up infrastructure and research initiatives. They also provided comparative insights into the pricing details of green hydrogen at both national and international levels, highlighting the challenges in making it economically competitive.



Furthermore, detailed presentations were given on the production processes of green hydrogen and its potential role in driving sustainable energy solutions. Applications such as green hydrogen-based power plants, submarines, airplanes, and various industries were discussed, demonstrating the vast opportunities that hydrogen can unlock in achieving a carbon-neutral future. The conference concluded with a strong message on the importance of collaborative efforts in research,

policy-making, and industrial deployment to accelerate the adoption of green hydrogen globally.

A total of 130 students actively participated from various institutions for the competitions. (Poster presentation and Elocution). In addition, 53 research articles were presented as part of the International Conference on Green Hydrogen Fuel of the Future.

Mushroom Culinary Challenge

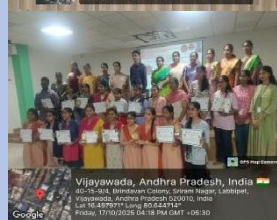

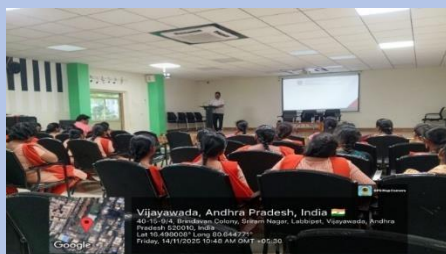
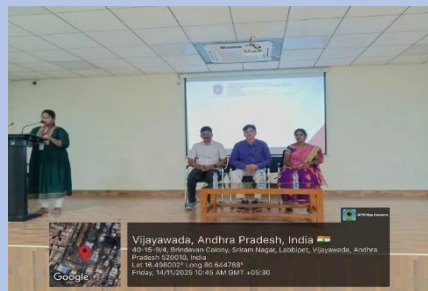
Awareness Programme on Career Opportunities

“R-Programming: Applications in Data Science and Research”

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of SDMS MK organized a Faculty Development Programme (FDP) titled **“R-Programming: Applications in Data Science and Research”** with hands-on training on **20 November 2025**. The objective of the FDP was to equip faculty members with essential skills in R-Programming, enhance their understanding of statistical computing, and strengthen their ability to apply data science tools in research and academic work. The programme commenced at 10.00 a.m. with a formal welcome of the guests on the dais, followed by a prayer song. The inaugural session included an address by the Principal and the IQAC Coordinator, setting the tone for the academic deliberations.

In his address, the Principal emphasized the vital connection between Faculty Development Programmes and research development. He highlighted that statistical tools form the backbone of modern research and explained how statistics is integrated into various research methodologies across all disciplines. He encouraged faculty members to actively utilize such academic platforms to strengthen their analytical and research capabilities. This was followed by the address of the IQAC Coordinator, who spoke about the practical applications of R-Programming in academic project development. She elaborated on how R can be effectively used for data handling, visualization, and statistical modeling, and stressed the importance of adopting modern analytical tools to improve the quality of student projects and research outcomes.

The technical sessions were delivered by the resource person, **Dr. G. Siva, Assistant Professor, Department of Statistics, VIT-AP University**. Dr. Siva holds a Ph.D. in Statistics from



Pondicherry Central University, Puducherry, completed in 2023, and qualified the State Eligibility Test (SET) conducted by the Government of Andhra Pradesh in 2022. His research expertise lies in Biostatistics and Classification Techniques, particularly ROC Analysis, which plays a significant role in medical data evaluation and diagnostic accuracy studies. He has received several prestigious awards, including the MN Das Memorial Young Scientist – 2025 Meritorious Award for Best Research Paper Presentation and the ISPS Young Statistician Award 2020 along with the Prof. Jayaram Sethuraman Gold Medal. He also secured multiple gold medals and cash prizes for academic excellence during his postgraduate studies and was a first-rank holder at the undergraduate level.



Dr. Siva has made notable academic contributions through research and publications, having published eight Scopus-indexed research articles, six of which appeared in SCI journals, and authored three books. He is currently guiding one Ph.D. scholar and has presented twenty research papers at national and international conferences. Additionally, he has delivered ten invited talks in various Faculty Development Programmes. During the FDP sessions, Dr. Siva explained that Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, and Deep Learning techniques are fundamentally derived from statistics. He highlighted the importance of data in decision-making and described how statistics is embedded in all aspects of real life. He introduced R as a powerful statistical computing tool capable of performing



complex computations efficiently.

During the hands-on sessions, participants were trained in using the R-console, including basic commands and data processing techniques. Faculty members learned to create histograms, bar graphs, and pie charts using R, and were introduced to the application of t-tests and their relevance in research. The sessions enabled participants to understand how statistical tests can be implemented

and interpreted using R. The FDP concluded with feedback from faculty members and a vote of thanks.

Overall, the FDP provided participants with valuable practical exposure to R-Programming and its applications in data science and research. Faculty members gained confidence in performing basic statistical operations, visualizing data, and conducting hypothesis testing using R. The programme enhanced their analytical skills, encouraged research-oriented thinking, and strengthened their ability to guide student projects more effectively.

They were introduced to industrial equipment and machinery, particularly boilers and steam heaters, and their role in large-scale production. 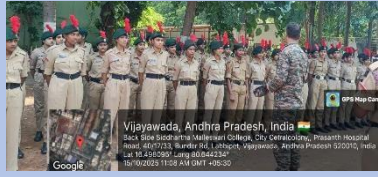

- To provide free preliminary screening for common eye and dental issues.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAM

The health camp was conducted on the college campus, providing students with convenient access. - Counselling on daily oral hygiene practices



During the session, dentists identified common issues such as plaque accumulation, early dental caries, and sensitivity among students. They also provided professional advice on maintaining proper oral hygiene and preventing dental problems.
