OBJECTIVE: To familiarize parents with the college's academic system, rules, regulations, student support services, and to foster effective parent–institution collaboration for the overall development and success of students.

PROGRAMME HIGHLIGHTS

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sri Durga Malleswara Siddhartha Mahila Kalasala organized a Parent Orientation Programme for the parents of First-Year Degree students to familiarize them with the institution's academic system, values, rules, regulations, facilities, and student support services. The programme aimed to establish effective communication between parents and the institution and to encourage their active involvement in the academic and overall development of their wards. The session commenced with a welcome address, followed by informative interactions and guidance by the Principal, IQAC Coordinator, and other college officials.

ADDRESSING BY THE PRINCIPAL



The Principal, Dr. P. V. Durgavathi, addressed the parents and provided an overview of the college, its history, vision, mission, achievements, recognitions, and academic environment. She explained the importance of regular attendance, discipline, good conduct, academic performance, and adherence to the college rules and regulations. ADDRESSING BY THE CHIEF WARDENS
